COVID-19 vaccinations

Under recent changes to health directions, the following must be vaccinated against COVID-19 by certain dates:

- Workers in residential aged care facilities
- Workers at construction sites
- Healthcare workers
- People working in schools, childcare and early education services (plus outside school hours care services)
- All Authorised Workers.

The Australian and Victorian governments decide who must be vaccinated, not MTHCS. Our role is to administer vaccinations, so if you need to organise your vaccination, contact our medical clinics in Sea Lake (phone 5070 2155) or Ouyen (phone 5092 1168).

COVID-19 PEAK

A reminder all of Victoria is classified as COVID-PEAK, which means there is a very high risk of COVID-19 transmission in the community. Under the COVID-Peak setting, visiting services are not allowed onsite at MTHCS, our allied health and community services are for essential health and wellbeing needs only, and visiting to aged care facilities is restricted to compassionate and end of life reasons only, for up to two people at a time from the same household. Families are asked to phone the facility to discuss their visiting requests.
