COVID-19 vaccination and testing

Both our Sea Lake and Ouyen medical clinics continue to provide COVID-19 testing and vaccination, by appointment. To make an appointment, please contact our medical clinic in Sea Lake (phone 5070 2155) or Ouyen (phone 5092 1168).

We have high vaccination rates in our communities and it's important not to panic if/when we get positive COVID-19 cases in our communities. Please keep doing what you know works – get your COVID-19 vaccination if you haven't already, wear a face mask, regularly use hand sanitiser, keep social distancing, and check-in using the QR code at every place you visit.
