Rest assured, they tasted just as good as they looked!



Mosquito virus concerns

Victorian health officials remain worried about the risk of mosquito-borne viruses spreading this summer.

Further detections of Murray Valley encephalitis (MVE) virus in mosquitoes at more locations across northern Victoria have been reported. These results demonstrate that MVE virus is increasing in the mosquito population and indicates a current and active risk to people in our region, so please protect yourself!



Early Years survey results

A huge thank you to everyone who took part in our Early Years survey late last year.

The survey was launched in November and we received 34 responses. We were really pleased with the range of detailed comments made. The responses show just how passionate you are about our service, while also highlighting some clear areas where we can make changes and improvements.

We have already completed cleaning and infection control audits at a number of services with more work to do in this space in 2023. We have implemented a number of changes to hygiene and cleaning based on the results of the audit, and will continue to review our enrolment and wait list processes.

We have also had conversations with MRCC around infrastructure needs in Murrayville, with plans to meet and discuss improvements around the issues raised.

A future survey is planned to track your responses to our efforts to make improvements where needed.
