Free RATs available in Buloke

COVID-19 remains a significant challenge for our community as a whole, and particularly for services such as ours who care for vulnerable

As part of a Victorian Government scheme, free COVID-19 testing kits are being made available through the Buloke Shire.

Everyone can collect up to two packs of five RATs per person, and two packs per household member.

You can collect RATs as many times as you need. If you run out of RATs, you can collect more to make sure you are prepared. If you want a PCR test, visit a GP respiratory clinic or see a GP about a referral to a pathology collection centre. You do not need a Medicare card.
