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Keeping ourselves safe

As we get used to living with COVID-19 in our everyday lives, there are things we can all do to make ourselves and others safer:

- Carry a face mask when leaving home. Face masks are required for everyone aged 8 and above in some locations, including on public transport and in sensitive settings such as hospitals and care facilities.
- Wear a face mask if you:
 - are indoors
 - have any COVID-19 symptoms
 - are with people who are at high risk to COVID-19
 - are in a space where you cannot physically distance.
- Get your next COVID-19 vaccine dose as soon as you are eligible. It is strongly recommended you have three doses of the vaccine for the best protection. Some people may be eligible for a fourth dose, while children 5-11 are recommended to have two doses. Contact our medical clinics to discuss your eligibility.
