Mallee Track Health and Community Service is committed to preventing child abuse and identifying risks early, and removing and reducing these risks.

We want children to be safe, happy and empowered. We support and respect all children, as well as our staff, families and volunteers. We have zero tolerance of child abuse, and all allegations and safety concerns will be treated very seriously and in line with our policies and procedures.

We have legal and moral obligations to contact authorities when we are worried about a child's safety. We have robust staff and volunteer recruitment processes, human resource management system and regular training on child abuse risks for all staff and volunteers.

We are committed to the cultural safety of Aboriginal children, the cultural safety of children from culturally diverse backgrounds, and providing a safe environment for children with a disability.
